If the doctor determines any of the findings from an exam merits more investigation, Chadwick has the facilities to perform many diagnostic tests promptly. The office features accredited x-ray, mammography, ultrasound, nuclear imaging and CT scan capabilities. "By working with board-certified radiologists and other specialists in the community, we are able to provide excellent continuity of care," Dr. Maloney says.

A clinical nurse specialist is available to help patients cope with stress. Chadwick also offers nutrition counseling, behavior modification, ambulatory care and other services.

Non-Invasive Testing

The practice is specially equipped to assess risks and diagnose problems of the heart, lungs, gastrointestinal and vascular systems. Chadwick's services include pulmonary and vascular labs as well as the necessary instruments to perform stress tests and echocardiograms. An ultrafast CT scanner can take detailed pictures of the coronary arteries to measure calcium levels and help determine the patient's risk for coronary artery disease. This test, known as "Chadwick HeartScan," provides an early warning so patients and their doctors can arrest the process before angioplasty or bypass surgery becomes necessary. This imaging system also enables early detection of malignant and pre-malignant lesions of the lungs and gastrointestinal tract.



Convenient and Accessible

To better serve patients, Chadwick offers Saturday hours and free parking in a convenient, handicapped-accessible location. The practice has affiliations with all Worcester area hospitals and accepts most major insurance carriers and HMOs.
